In order to ensure high expectations are being held, teachers will:

- Plan and implement daily lessons that follow Bridges and HMH curriculum with fidelity while addressing learner variability.
- Use data to inform responsive literacy and math instruction
- Consistently teach curriculum **instructional routines and strategies** across grade levels and classroom including HMH, Bridges, Open Court, and Heggerty, as applicable
- Frequently and intentionally **monitor** that programs are implemented with fidelity while being responsive to learner variability
- Plan for and implement all components of the instructional reading block (Foundational Skills, Vocabulary, Reading, and Writing) and math block (Number Corner, Bridges lessons, and workplaces)
- Provide systematic instruction during intervention to develop student understanding of foundational skills
- Adhere to BCPS pacing guides
- Meet weekly as a grade level team for co-planning with ILT
- Post and unpack objectives written in student-friendly language
- STUDENTS WILL ENGAGE IN PRODUCTIVE STRUGGLE EVERY DAY.

In order to promote a sense of belonging, teachers will:

- Embed opportunities for direct social skill instruction (including teaching and modeling) in daily learning activities
- Assign weekly classroom jobs
- Greet students by name at the door every morning
- Conduct morning meetings with a focus on building a sense of belonging, implementing the HES Code of Conduct and utilizing SEL practices/skills.
- Adhere to Bee-havior Matrix procedures and walkie protocols
- Participate in Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan aligned to our Code of Conduct
- Follow Attendance Protocol with fidelity
